- 1950.** Narrated by Abu Huraira: Allah's Messenger said, "The example of a believer is that of a fresh tender plant; from whatever direction the wind comes, it bends it but when the wind becomes quiet, it becomes straight again. Similarly, a believer is afflicted with calamities (but he remains patient till Allah removes his difficulties.) And Al-Fajir (an impious wicked evil-doer) is like a pine tree which keeps hard and straight till Allah cuts (breaks) it down when he wishes." [7:547:-O.B]
- 1951.** Narrated by Abu Huraira: Allah's Messenger said, "If Allah wants to do good to somebody, He afflicts him with trials." [7:548-O.B]
